Prestigious British Scholarships for A Level Studies

Equine Park, Selangor, Malaysia: 23rd August 2010.. In rewarding bright and deserving Malaysian students, The Alice Smith School is offering a limited number of full academic scholarships in 2011 for post-SPM students to pursue our British A Level programme at the Secondary Campus in Equine Park.

The length of each Alice Smith Scholarship will be **two-and-a-half years**. This is in order to acclimatise the chosen scholars to the British education system (and to potentially different learning styles) and to allow for a two-year A Level course.

The scholarships will run from January 2011 to July 2013. From January until July 2011 of the first year, the scholars will join Year 11 (GCSE Year) and take some GCSE examinations in chosen core subjects such as Mathematics, English and Sciences. Others may be available depending on the individual scholar's strengths. They will then progress to the Sixth Form (Years 12 and 13) and take their A Level examinations during the summer of those years. Applications for the Alice Smith Scholarships are online and the application form is available for download until 10th September 2010. **The application must be submitted to the school by no later than 17th September 2010.**

The selected scholar will have the opportunity to study in a beautiful purpose-built campus, situated on 25 acres of land in Equine Park. Our dedicated Sixth Form Centre for Learning is modelled on the latest educational research, and provides an excellent environment which encourages senior students to develop as independent learners and prepares them for the rigours of advanced level study and university life. It is complemented by a range of specialist faculty areas including music suites, an Art and Design Centre, a Design and Technology Centre and a film studio and editing suite. The Secondary Campus also offers excellent sporting facilities including a ten lane Olympic-sized swimming pool, a large Sports Hall, football and rugby pitches and a covered basketball court. Much of the design of the Secondary Campus is aimed at providing teaching and learning areas based on the concept of open, student-centred learning. In 2011, a new dedicated building comprising Media, Business and Economics Learning Spaces, a Careers and University Guidance Centre and a Business Centre will be completed to cater to the increasing number of Sixth Form students.

"The underlying aim of the Alice Smith Scholarships is to benefit bright Malaysian students with limited financial means in pursuit of excellence at our school which is one of the most prestigious and respected British international schools in Asia. This annual scholarship is part of the Alice Smith School's way of extending its social responsibility to the Malaysians. As a not-for-profit educational foundation, all the school's resources continue to be focused on the development and well-being of the students, as they have been since the school was established in 1946," said Valerie Thomas-Peter, Director of School.
